

Subject: Continuation and Revision in funding pattern of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Post Matric Scholarship to students belonging to Scheduled Castes for studies in India (PMS-SC)' from 2020-21 till 2025-26.

Sir / Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that the continuation and revision of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Post Matric Scholarship to students belonging to Scheduled Castes for studies in India (PMS-SC)" for the period 2020-21 to 2025-26 has been approved by the Government.

2. The revised scheme is aimed at bringing a transformatory impact on the poorest SC households, and is based on principles of timely delivery, comprehensive accountability, continuous monitoring and total transparency. While the revised guidelines of the Scheme shall be issued shortly, the major modifications approved for effective implementation and better monitoring of the scheme are as follows:

- a) The existing committed liability system in the funding pattern will be replaced with a 60: 40 sharing pattern between the Centre and States (90:10 in case of North Eastern States) of the average demand for the scheme for three year period 2017-18 to 2019-20, with a 5% annual increase each year. The above shall be applicable from 2020-21 onwards and the scheme will be continued up to 2025-26. For the year 2020-21, the central share would be 60% of the average demand of the last three years (2017-18 to 2019-20).
- b) For smooth administration of the scheme, the following conditions will govern the release of the central assistance for this scheme:
 - i. The State Governments will ensure that the poorest students belonging to the SC households shall get top priority for coverage under the scheme. This would include (i) students from SC households with three or more deprivations as per SECC-2011, (ii) the students from the households where one or both the parents are illiterate and (iii) the students who have

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passed 10th standard from a State Government/ Municipality/Local Body schools. Awareness drive will be undertaken by the State Governments/UTs about the scheme through the Gram Panchayats Notice Boards, school committees, and discussions in the parent-teacher association meetings, public awareness in order to minimize any misuse.

- ii. Only such higher educational Institutions which maintain the laid down academic standards shall be covered under the scheme. All such participating institutions shall get NAAC/NBA accreditation before 2024 for continuation in the scheme from 2025-26 onwards. In case of schools and diploma institutions, only those which are recognised by the competent authority shall be considered under the scheme.
- iii. The scheme shall be run on an online platform with robust cyber security measures that would assure transparency, accountability, efficiency, and timely delivery of the assistance without any delays. The National Scholarship Portal (NSP) would be suitably modified for this purpose. If any State is already having a running online portal that fulfils all the laid down parameters, they can continue with it, but share the data on real-time basis to the National Scholarship Portal or any other portal as specified by the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment.
- iv. The States shall undertake fool-proof verification of the eligibility, caste status, Aadhar identification and bank account details on the online portal. Apart from this, they shall maintain a complete database of the beneficiaries under various scholarship schemes to ensure de-duplication of the beneficiaries.
- Release of funds to the students shall be automatically linked to the aadhar-based attendance system, which shall be a mandatory provision in the scheme.
- vi. Transfer of financial assistance to the students under the scheme shall be on DBT mode, and preferably using the Aadhar Enabled Payment System. Starting from 2021-22, the Central share in the scheme would be released on DBT mode directly into the bank accounts of the students, after ensuring that the concerned State Government has released their share. For this purpose, all State Governments would be encouraged to have an escrow account for the scheme so as to ensure release of funds as per the given schedule of payments.
- vii. There shall be thorough evaluation of the outcomes of the scheme in regular intervals to ascertain the effectiveness of scheme implementation and for tracking the progress of the students. This may include conduct of social audits once a year, annual third party evaluation, and half-yearly self-audited reports from each institution. In order to ensure proper accountability, physical verifications at various levels viz Block/District/State levels shall be done covering at least 10% of the institutions/students, chosen randomly through an algorithm.
- c) Each State will prepare an Annual Action Plan in February each year for the following academic year reflecting various details that shall be communicated by the Department. These annual plans will be appraised and approved by the Central Government. There shall be incentives and disincentives for the States/UTs based on a set of indicators covering - (i) payments as per the given

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time schedule, (ii) coverage from the poorest households and (iii) academic outcomes of the scholarship-holders.

3. For the Financial Year 2020-21 all the State/UT Governments are requested to send the following information for being brought under the revised system within the given time limits:

- A formal letter of acceptance of the above revised system for administering the PMS-SC scheme before 15th Jan 2021.
- b) Confirmation of the actual demand for the scheme in 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 to determine the revised central share for 2020-21, along with the demand for 2020-21: **before 15**th **January 2021**.
- c) The database of the students enrolled in the academic year 2020-21 (renewals and fresh cases) along with the details of releases made in each case for 2020-21 may be shared with the central portal in the format and as per the APIs (for data sharing and for transaction details) before 1st Feb 2021. Where releases to the students haven't been made, the same shall be made before this deadline.

4. The Central share as per the revised formula would be released to the State Governments based on the data as stated above after adjusting the central assistance already released during the current year. Considering that there shall be no carry forward of the central share for 2020-21 to the next financial year and therefore all States/UTs are requested to send the complete proposals and the database as stated above along with pending Utilization Certificates and any other documents that have been called for.

GUIDELINES POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO SCHEDULED CASTES FOR STUDIES IN INDIA (January, 2021- March, 2026)

GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE & EMPOWERMENT Department of Social Justice & Empowerment

(January, 2021)

SCHEME OF POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO SCHEDULED CASTES FOR STUDIES IN INDIA PMS-SC (with effect from January, 2021)

1. Objective

1.1 The objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the gross enrolment ratio in higher education of SC students with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

2. Scope

2.1 These scholarships are available for studies in India only and the awardees are selected by the State Government/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs (i.e. the State/UT in which permanently settled or domiciled, as per the terms of domicile decided by the State).

2.2 This is applicable to all the students who are currently beneficiaries of the scheme as well as fresh admissions.

3. Definitions:

- a) "Group 1: Degree and Post Graduate level professional courses" shall mean: all Professional courses in Medicine, Engineering, Technology, Planning, Architecture, Design, Fashion Technology, Agriculture, Veterinary & Allied Sciences, Management, Business Finance /Administration, Computer Science/ Applications. (ii) Post Graduate Diploma courses in various branches of management & medicine. (iii) C.A./I.C.W.A./C.S./I.C.F.A. etc. (Applicable at day scholar rate only Rs 550 per month) (iv) M.Phil, Ph.D and Post-Doctoral Programmes (D.Lit., D.Sc. etc.), Group I, Group II and Group III courses. (vi) L.L.B, Integrated L.L.B, L.L.M
- b) "Group 2: Other Professional Courses leading to Degree, Diploma, Certificate" shall mean all Professional Courses leading to Degree, M Ed./ M. Pharma, Diploma, Certificate in areas like Pharmacy (B Pharma), Nursing(B Nursing), BFS, other paramedical branches like rehabilitation, diagnostics etc., Mass Communication, Hotel Management & Catering, Travel/Tourism/Hospitality Management, Interior Decoration,

Nutrition Dietetics, Commercial Art, Financial Services (e.g. Banking, Insurance, Taxation etc.) for which entrance qualification is minimum Sr. Secondary (10+2) and Vocational stream, ITI courses and Polytechnic where entrance qualification is Class XII or above.

- c) "Group 3: Graduate and Post Graduate course" shall mean: courses not covered under Group 1 & Group 2 e.g. B.A / B.Sc / B.Com etc. M.A/ M. Sc/ M.Com etc.
- d) "Group 4: All post-matriculation (Post Class X level) non-degree courses" shall mean: All post-matriculation level non-degree courses for which entrance qualification is High School (Class X), e.g. Senior secondary certificate (class XI and XII); both general and vocational stream, ITI courses, 3 year diploma courses in Polytechnics, etc. Note: The list of courses in various groups is indicative and States/UTs may add courses as per laid down standard in the State/UT.
- e) "Compulsory non-refundable fees" shall mean: fee payable for enrolment/registration, tuition, games, Union, Library, Magazine, Medical Examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the scholar to the institution or University/Board, but does not include Refundable deposits like caution money, security deposit will, however, be excluded.
- f) "Demand" for a year indicates the total fund requirement for release of scholarship to all eligible students for release of scholarship under the scheme as per the entitlements for that <u>particular</u> <u>year.</u>

4. Eligibility of Educational Institutions

4.1 Only such higher educational Institutions which maintain the laid down academic standards shall be covered under the scheme. All such participating institutions shall get NAAC/NBA accreditation before 2024 for continuation in the scheme from 2025-26 onwards. In case of schools and diploma institutions, only those which are recognized by the competent authority shall be considered under the scheme.

4.2 Accordingly, scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized postmatriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized Institutions/ Universities/ Colleges falling in any of the following 9 categories of institutes and the PMS-SC scholarships can be reimbursed/availed for intermediate, Diploma, Vocational Training Certificate, Graduate, Post Graduate courses etc. :

i. Institutions of National Importance;

- ii. Central University/ State University/ Autonomous colleges recognized by UGC and Universities /Colleges recognized under section 2(f) of UGC Act;
- iii. Deemed Universities;
- iv. Private Universities recognized by State/Centre with 'A' level or equivalent accreditation by NAAC, NBA;
- Private Professional Institutions affiliated to a recognized Central/State University and covered by a Fee Fixation Committee as mandated by Supreme Court;
- vi. Recognized schools/colleges for Classes XI and class XII;
- vii. Diploma granting Institutions as recognized by State/UT Governments;
- viii. Vocational Training Institute affiliated to National Council of Vocational Training (NCVT);
- ix. Institutions affiliated/ approved by the appropriate bodies like NMC/AICTE etc. or any regulatory body established by State/UT/Centre.

Provided that where a particular number of seats for a particular course have been recognized / authorized by the concerned regulatory authority, the admissions shall be restricted to those numbers and courses.

4.3 The following conditions regarding details of courses offered, performance of the institute, Aadhaar based attendance system is also required to be adhered by the Institutions/Universities/Colleges in order to be eligible under the scheme:

- i. The Institutions/Colleges at the time of submitting scholarship applications of students will also submit/ upload details of their registration, affiliation and accreditation, courses being offered and number of seats approved for each course on the portal created for this purpose.
- ii. To be eligible for scholarships for their students in any academic year, the institutions should have a minimum of 50% renewal in respect of students availing post-matric scholarship for the previous academic year. However, where the institution is able to give good and sufficient reasons for not achieving minimum of 50% renewal, the above mentioned limit will not apply. Good and sufficient reasons imply natural calamities like flood/ drought/ unforeseen circumstances/ law and order problem etc.
- iii. The scholarship benefits shall be linked with Aadhar based attendance system. Therefore, the college/Institution will maintain an Aadhar based attendance system on a daily basis and will submit attendance details on the portal.

iv. Institutes will submit half-yearly self-audited reports to the State Governments in a prescribed format.

5. Conditions of Eligibility of Students

5.1 The scholarships are open to Nationals of India.

5.2 Only those candidates who belong to Scheduled Castes so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs /domiciled as determined by the State/UT and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.

5.3 The ceiling on age limit for admission as regular student in different classes should be decided by concerned Institutions.

5.4 Candidates who, after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in a different subject e.g. Intermediate Science after Intermediate Arts or B.Com after B.A. or M.A in one subject after M.A in other subjects will not be eligible.

5.5 Students who pursue their studies through correspondence courses are also eligible. The term correspondence includes distant and continuing education for courses in Central/ State Universities only. Non-refundable fees shall be paid and no maintenance allowance will be paid.

5.6 All children of the same parents/guardians will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme.

5.7 A scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the student can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipends, whichever is more beneficial to him/her, and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of the Institution about the option made. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this scheme from the date he/she accepts another scholarship/stipend. The student can however, accept free lodging or a grant or adhoc monetary help from the State Government or any other source for the purchase of books, equipment or for meeting the expenses on board and lodging in addition to the scholarship amount paid under this scheme.

5.8 Scholarship holders who are receiving coaching in any of the pre-examination training centers with financial assistance from the Central Government/ State Government will not be eligible for stipend under the coaching scheme for the duration of the coaching programme.

6. Coverage of Students

6.1 Although many SC students have availed benefits under this scheme and have occupied high positions in the society, still the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SCs in higher education (23.0%) lags behind the national average (27.0%). It is the endeavour of the Government to raise the GER of SCs in higher education from 23.0 % to the national average in the next five years. Similarly, the GER in Higher Secondary education of SCs has to increase from the current 56% to the national average in the next five years. Towards this end, special focus of the implementing agencies is required to achieve the goal.

6.2 The State Governments shall ensure that the poorest students belonging to the SC households shall get top priority for coverage under the scheme. This would include (i) students from SC households with three or more deprivations as per SECC-2011, (ii) the students from the households where one or both the parents are illiterate and (iii) the students who have passed 10th standard from a State Government/ Municipality/Local Body schools. In this regard, States/UTs will launch special campaign to identify and cover such students.

6.3 States/UTs may adopt methodology suitable to the local conditions for identification of such students e.g. SC majority districts/blocks/villages may be taken first for identification of poorest students or students leaving class 10th or 12th class may be tracked in association with the education department or data emanating from other Central/State schemes indicating the dropouts rates or other sources as deemed fit. Such students may be encouraged to enrol and avail scholarships, in a campaign mode. Such students will be helped for identification of courses also as per their skills.

6.4 Awareness drive shall be undertaken by the State Governments/UTs about the scheme through the Gram Panchayats Notice Boards, school committees, and discussions in the parent-teacher association meetings and other public awareness drives, in order to extend its coverage and also minimize any misuse by unscrupulous elements.

6.5 The States are required to take up identification of the students for fresh enrolment by taking up systematic drive covering all the higher secondary schools and encouraging the pupils who dropped out after Class 12th to come back to higher education.

6.6 It is essential that the fresh enrolments to the extent possible are made in the courses which are having employment potential. For this purpose, the State may do an exercise in consultation with the Higher Education Department of the State Government, and the State Skill Mission for identifying courses which would improve the employment potential of the students. It is strongly advised that fresh enrolment may be made in these courses. 6.7. State Government will ensure that the beneficiary, at the time of admission, applies for the scholarship also. In this regard, the State Government may open facilitation centers or nominate a nodal officer in the educational institutions so that the entry in to the student database for renewals and fresh admissions can be done in a stipulated timeframe.

7. Means Test

7.1 Scholarships will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lakh Fifty thousand only). Income certificate is required to be taken once only i.e. at the time of admission only to courses which are continuing for more than one year. The income certificate shall be issued by the Authority as decided by the State Government.

8. Components of the Scholarship

- 8.1 The component of scholarship includes the following for complete duration of the course:
 - i. Compulsory non-refundable fees including tuition fee, as fixed by the Fee Fixation/Rationalization Committee of the State Government, payable half-yearly
 - ii. Academic allowance payable half-yearly

8.2. All seats filled through arbitrary and non-transparent processes (including management quota, NRI quota, spot admissions etc) without following the merit criteria as decided by the State Government are not eligible for these scholarships.

9. Selection of Candidates

9.1 All the eligible Scheduled Caste candidates will be given scholarships subject to the application of Means Test prescribed in this Scheme.

9.2. The students from the poorest households (See Para 6) will be proactively followed for admission in the suitable courses.

9.2. Candidates belonging to one State but studying in other State will be awarded scholarships by the State to which they belong. Students domiciled in a State/UT but holding SC Certificate in other State/UT can avail scholarship from the State/UT of domicile.

10. Funding Pattern of the Scheme

10.1 There will be a 60: 40 sharing ratio between the Centre and States (90:10 in case of North Eastern States) of the average demand for the scheme for three year period 2017-18 to 2019-20, with a 5% annual increase each year. The above shall be applicable from 2020-21 onwards and the scheme will be continued upto the financial year 2025-26.

10.2 Thus, for the purpose of determining the demand for the year 2020-21, the average demand of 2017-18 to 2019-20, or the actual demand, whichever is lesser, will be considered for each State/UT. For subsequent years i.e. 2021-22 & onwards, the demand of all States put together will be limited by a 5% annual increase over the average demand for the scheme for the three year period 2017-18 to 2019-20. The PAC will ensure that the overall increase will not exceed 105% of previous year demand. The Ministry will have the flexibility of adjusting the allocation of funds between the States subject to the total allocation approved, without disrupting the 60:40 sharing ratio between the Centre and the States.

10.3. All the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations implementing the scheme will maintain the data of all the beneficiaries on their online portal and will distinctly mention the amount of scholarship under various components as mentioned in the Scheme.

11. Payment Mechanism

11.1 The entire scholarship amount, including the tuition fees and academic allowance will be paid into the account of the students ONLY through DBT. Starting from 2021-22, the Central share in the scheme would be released on DBT mode directly into the bank accounts of the students, after ensuring that the concerned State Government has released their share.

11.2 The scholarship amount shall be disbursed in two half-yearly installments - by 15th August and 26th January each year. There shall be no delays in payment of the scholarships.

For this purpose the State shall ensure that the two installments are disbursed to the students by 15th July and 31st December respectively so that the Central share can also be released in time.

11.3 The State Government/ UT Government will release 40% (in two installments of 20% each) of the scholarship (10% in the case of North Eastern States) on the online portal created for this purpose. Based on this, the central share of 60% (in two installments of 30% each) (90% in the case of North Eastern States) will be released.

11.4 Payment of scholarship/ maintenance and any other admissible allowance should be made to beneficiaries directly into their accounts, preferably through Aadhaar enabled payment system from 2021-22.

11.5 The Ministry of Social Justice vide notification number 428 dated Feb, 16, 2017 has notified Aadhaar as identity document under Section 7 of Aadhaar Act 2016 for all Scholarship Schemes w.e.f. 16th February 2017.

11.6 The authentication through Aadhaar would be compulsory at the time of renewals, if not provided earlier at the time of admission.

12. Duration and Renewal of Awards

12.1 The award once made will be payable up to the completion of course subject to good conduct and attendance of 75% in every academic year. The attendance will be verified through Aadhar based attendance System.

12.2 If a scholar is unable to appear in the annual examination owing to illness, the award may be renewed subject to production of medical certificate from prescribed authority and acceptance of the same by institution /college.

12.3 If according to the Regulations of a University/Institution, a student is promoted to the next higher class even though he/she may not have actually passed in lower class and is required to take examination of the junior class again after sometime, he/she will be entitled to scholarship for the class to which he/she is promoted if the student is otherwise eligible for scholarship.

13. IT Framework

13.1. The scheme shall be run on an online platform with robust cyber security measures that would assure transparency, accountability, efficiency, and timely delivery of the assistance without any delays. The National Scholarship Portal (NSP) would be suitably modified for this purpose.

13.2. If any State is already a running online portal that fulfils all the laid down parameters, they can continue with it, but share the data on real-time basis to the National Scholarship Portal or any other portal as specified by the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment in due course through instructions for enabling constant monitoring. Therefore, all States/UTs implementing the scheme will migrate to online processing of disbursal of scholarships, where not already done. The scholarship portal should mandatorily have the following features:

- a) At the time of admission, every student should provide an Aadhaar ID/Aadhaar EID and other alternative form of ID as per this Ministry's notification no. 428 dated 16.02.2017 which will enable elimination of duplication and false claims. The Aadhaar authentication is mandatory in case of renewals, if not provided at the time of admission. The Aadhaar number entered by the students should go through demo-auth on real-time basis before allowing entry into the registration portal.
- b) The States shall undertake fool-proof verification of the eligibility, caste status, Aadhaar identification and bank account details on the online portal. There shall be no upload of any documents or any certificates into the system. All data should be auto-verified by linking databases such as (i) school boards' results, including the CBSE/ICSE along with the certificates maintained by them; (ii) database of income certificates and caste certificates issued by State/District Administration and (iii) databases maintained by the Universities and Colleges, using Aadhar number as the link.
- c) All verification process of the students should be done using the above authenticated databases automatically using the digital process. There should be no system of verification by the institutions or even the district level officers. (They can come in only if any case of failure of machine-based authentication.)
- d) The Aadhaar based biometric attendance shall be recorded by each institution.
- e) There shall be no system of calling for the bank account details of the students and authenticating it. All payments must go through ABPS after checking the Aadhaar number with NPCI mapper.

- f) The renewals should be automatic based on passing the previous year examination and having the required attendance. There should not be any requirement for the student to apply for renewals.
- g) A performance module to monitor the progress of student as well as performance of the institution should be suitably designed and incorporated.
- h) Apart from this, they shall maintain a complete database of the beneficiaries under various other scholarship schemes to ensure de-duplication of the beneficiaries.

14. Annual Action Plan

14.1 Every participating State/UT, on or before 28th February of the preceding year, will prepare a State level Plan for PMS scheme. Any other initiatives of the State Govt. on similar lines may be mentioned separately in the Action Plan. The Plan should give clearly the targets, eligibility, proposed coverage separately for poorest households, processes for identification, identification of courses having employment potential, systems for monitoring etc.

14.2 The Department will constitute an Appraisal Committee to appraise and approve the Annual Action Plans. These plans would be appraised at the Centre and the outlay for each State would be finalized before 15th April, 2020, as per the annual increase indicated under the funding pattern. The constitution of the committee will be informed through separate instructions.

15. Performance of the States/UTs

15.1 The performance of the States/UTs would be measured annually on certain parameters like (i) payments as per the given time schedule, (ii) coverage from the poorest households and (iii) academic outcomes of the scholarship-holders (iv) Implementation of Aadhar based attendance, (v) Digitisation of various certificates required for determining eligibility etc.

15.2. The States/UTs would be ranked on the above parameters and top performing States will be rewarded accordingly. The details in this regard will be prepared after consultations, and will be shared through instructions in due course.

16. Announcement of the Scheme by States/UTs

16.1 All the State Governments/UT Administrations will announce starting from April, the details of the scheme and invite applications by issuing an advertisement in the leading newspapers of the State and through their respective websites/ Scholarship portals and other mode of media. All requests for application forms and other particulars should be addressed to the Government of State/Union Territory Administration to which the scholars actually belong. The applicant should submit the completed application to the prescribed authority on the portal specified for this purpose before the last date prescribed for receipt of applications.

17. Procedure for Applying

17.1 An application for scholarship will be made online on scholarship portal giving the details only of the Aadhaar number and the details of the course admitted. The verification of the income, caste and merit details should be auto-checked from the databases which are linked online for instant verification. The process should be entirely paperless.

17.2. Until the above system is brought into effect, the documents may be scanned and uploaded which include: passport size photograph, digital signature, copy of each of certificates, diploma, degree etc. in respect of all examinations passed, Caste certificate duly signed by the authorized Officer, Income certificate issued by the competent authority as prescribed by the State Govt.

18. Evaluation/Social Audit and follow up action

18.1. There shall be thorough evaluation of the outcomes of the scheme in regular intervals to ascertain the effectiveness of scheme implementation and for tracking the progress of the students. This may include conduct of social audits once a year, annual third-party evaluation, and half-yearly self-audited reports from each institution.

18.2. The social audits are to be conducted by the Social Audit Units of the State Government formed by the Ministry of Rural Development, Govt of India duly meeting the cost from the administrative cost of the scheme.

18.3. The State Government shall also set up a robust monitoring mechanism for monitoring the academic progress of the students enrolled to the scheme.

18.4. The students who are found to be lagging behind should be provided remedial coaching so that their academic outcome shall not be less than the average academic outcomes. The State Action Plan should contain clear provisions for this.

18.5. In order to ensure proper accountability, physical verifications at various levels viz. Block/District/State levels shall be done by the States/UTs covering at least 10% of the institutions/students, chosen randomly through an algorithm. All private institutions offering courses at the level of graduation or above shall, however, be mandatorily inspected annually.

19. Administrative Charges

19.1. The administrative cost for administration, monitoring and evaluation shall be limited to 1% of the annual outlay.

19.2. Each State/UT shall project the requirement of funds for undertaking the monitoring of the system in the Annual Action Plans. This would be considered by the PAC by ensuring that the total outflow on this count does not exceed 1% of the annual outlay.

19.3. The PAC shall give first priority in approving administrative charges for development of IT infrastructure, setting up of Technical Support Group cum Project Monitoring Unit at the Central/State level and social audits.

20. Mechanism for redressal of grievances

20.1. There shall be a online grievance redressal mechanism linking all the authorities responsible for implementation on the scholarship portal.

20.2. The student shall be able to lodge the grievance either through the portal or by a mobile app.

20.3. Every institution shall have a Grievance Redressal Officer (GROs) who is responsible for entertaining the grievances and resolving them by following up with the appropriate authority.

20.4. The non-resolution of the grievance at the institution level shall automatically escalated to the district and later to the State level for resolution.

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CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEME OF POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO SCHEDULED CASTES FOR STUDIES IN INDIA PMS-SC (with effect from April, 2018)

I. Object

The objective of the scheme is to provide/supplement financial assistance to the Scheduled Caste students studying at post matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

II. Scope

These scholarships are available for studies in India only and are awarded by the Government of the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs i.e. permanently settled or domiciled, as per the terms of domicile decided by the State, will be eligible to avail PMS-SC from the domiciled State/UT. The domicile State/UT shall keep the parent State informed with all particulars.

III. Conditions of Eligibility of students

(i) The scholarships are open to nationals of India.

(ii) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized Institutions/ Universities/ Colleges, where PMS-SC can be availed for intermediate, graduate, post graduate courses and include the following :

- a. Institutions of National Importance;
- b. Central University/ State University/ Autonomous colleges recognized by UGC and Universities /Colleges recognized under section 2(f) and 12(b) of UGC Act.;
- c. Deemed Universities;
- d. Private Universities recognized by State/Centre with 'A' level or equivalent accreditation by NAAC, NBA;

- e. Private Professional Institutions affiliated to a recognized Central/State University and covered by Fee Fixation Committee as mandated by Supreme Court;
- f. Recognized schools/colleges for Classes XI and class XII;
- g. Diploma granting Institutions as recognized by State/UT Governments;
- h. Vocational Training Institute affiliated to National Council of Vocational Training (NCVT);
- i. Institutions affiliated/ approved by the appropriate bodies like MCI/AICTE etc or any regulatory body established by State/ Centre. Provided that where a particular number of seats for a particular course have been recognized / authorized by the concerned regulatory authority. The admissions shall be restricted to those numbers and courses provided further that at each level only one course of study shall be allowed;
- iii. Only those candidates who belong to Scheduled Castes so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs /domiciled as determined by the State/UT and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.
- iv. The ceiling on age limit for admission as regular student in different classes should be decided by concerned Institutions
- v. Candidates who after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. I.Sc. after I.A. or B.Com. after B.A. in other subject will not be eligible.
- vi. Students who, after having completed their educational career in one professional line, e.g. L.L.B. after B.T./B.Ed. will not be eligible.
- vii. Students pursuing Post Graduate courses in medicine will be eligible if they are not allowed to practice during the period of their course.
- viii. Students who pursue their studies through correspondence courses are also eligible. The term correspondence includes distant and continuing education for courses in

Central/ State Universities only. Non-refundable fee shall be paid directly to the Students account

- viii. All children of the same parents/guardians will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme.
- ix. A scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the student can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipends, whichever is more beneficial to him/her and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of the Institution about the option made. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this scheme from the date he/she accepts another scholarship/stipend. The student can however, accept free lodging or a grant or adhoc monetary help from the State Government or any other source for the purchase of books, equipment or for meeting the expenses on board and lodging in addition to the scholarship amount paid under this scheme.
- x. Scholarship holders who are receiving coaching in any of the pre-examination training centers with financial assistance from the Central Government/ State Government will not be eligible for stipend under the coaching schemes for the duration of the coaching programme.

Note 1: It is mentioned under the item III (condition of eligibility) of this scheme that the scholarship will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions, the list of courses grouped (I to IV) is only illustrative and not exhaustive. The State Governments/Union Territory Administrations are, thus, themselves competent to decide the appropriate grouping of courses at their level.

IV. Conditions of Eligibility of Institutions/Universities/Colleges

- 1. The Institutions/Colleges at the time of submitting Scholarship applications of students studying will also submit/ upload details of their registration, affiliation and accreditation, courses being offered and number of seats approved for each course.
- 2. The college/Institution will ensure minimum 50% of renewal in respect of students availing post-matric scholarship for the academic year, before applying for Scholarship

for the next academic year provided where the institution is able to give good and sufficient reasons for not achieving minimum of 50% renewal; the above mentioned limit will not apply. The good and sufficient reasons imply natural calamities like flood/ drought/ unforeseen circumstances/ law and order problem etc.

V. Means Test

Scholarships will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lacs Fifty thousand only).

Note 1: So long as either of the parents (or husband in the case of married unemployed girl student) is alive, only income of the parents/husband, as the case may be, from all sources has to be taken into account only and of no other member even though they may be earning. In the form of income declaration, income is to be declared on this basis. Only in the case where both the parents (or husband in the case of married but unemployed girl student) have died, the income of the guardian who is supporting the student in his/her studies has to be taken. Such students whose parent's income is affected due to unfortunate death of one of earning parents and resultantly comes within the income ceiling prescribed under the scheme, shall become eligible for scholarship, subject to their fulfilling other conditions of eligibility, from the month in which such sad incidence takes place. Applications for scholarships from such students can be considered even after lapse of last date of receipt of applications, on compassionate grounds.

Note 2: House rent allowance received by the parents of a student shall be exempted from the computation of 'income' if the same has been permitted to be exempted for the purpose of Income tax.

Note 3: Income certificate is required to be taken once only i.e. at the time of admission to courses which are continuing for more than one year.

Note 4: Income Ceiling would be reviewed periodically.

VI. Components of the Scholarship

The component of scholarship includes the following for complete duration of the course:-

- i. maintenance allowance,
- ii. reimbursement of compulsory non- refundable fees,
- iii. study tour charges,
- iv. thesis typing,
- v. book allowance,
- vi. book bank facility,
- vii. additional allowances for SC students with disabilities for the complete duration of the course.

Note1: Normally the term 'Hostel' is applicable to a common residential building and a common mess for the students runs under the supervision of the educational institution authorities. In case the college authorities are unable to provide accommodation in the college Hostel, an approved place of residence can also be treated as Hostel for the purpose of this scheme. The place will be approved by the Head of the Institution after due inspection and keeping in view the rules and regulations laid down by the University, if any. In such case, a certificate to the effect that the student is residing in an approved place of residence, as he is unable to get accommodation in the college hostel should be furnished by the Head of the Institution.

It is further clarified that such deemed hostels should consist of such accommodation as is hired at least by a group of 5(five) students living together, usually with common mess arrangements.

Note 2 : Scholars who are entitled to free board and/or lodging will be paid maintenance charge at 1/3rd at Hostellers' rate.

(ii) Additional Allowances for SC students with disabilities

a. Reader Allowance for blind Scholars

Level of Course	Reader Allowance (Rs. Per month)
Group I,II	240

Group IV	160

- b. Provision of transport allowance upto Rs.160/- per month for disabled students, if such students do not reside in the hostel, which is within the premises of educational institution. The disability as per the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 is defined as blindness, low-vision, leprosy-cured, hearing impairment, locomotors disability, mental retardation and mental illness.
- c. Escort Allowance of Rs.160/- per month for severally handicapped day scholar students with low extremity disability.
- d. Special Pay of Rs.160/- per month is admissible to any employee of the hostel willing to extend help to a severely orthopedically handicapped student residing in hostel of an educational institution, who may need the assistance of a helper.
- e. Allowance of Rs.240/- per month towards extra coaching to mentally retarded and mentally ill students.

The provisions in (b) to (d) will also apply to such leprosy-cured students.

- **Note 1:** The disabled students belonging to Scheduled Castes covered under the Scheme can also get such additional benefits from other Schemes, which are not covered under the scheme.
- **Note 2:** The disability as defined under the said Act has to be certified by competent medical authority of the State Govt./UT Administration

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iii. Compulsory non-refundable fees but will not include one-time upfront payment fees for full course:

- a. Scholars will be paid enrolment/registration, tuition, games, Union, Library, Magazine, Medical Examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the scholar to the institution or University/Board. Refundable deposits like caution money, security deposit will, however, be excluded.
- Note: Payment of one time lump sum fees for full course in Government and Private Institutions shall not be eligible. The fees claimed against management quota seats, spot admission seat in any Institution /University will not be reimbursed.
 - b. Every State shall constitute a Fee Rationalization Committee (FRC) for review and rationalization of fee structures for disciplines/courses/institutes which are not otherwise covered by the Fee Fixation Committee required to be constituted as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

(iv) Study Tours

Study tour charges up to a maximum of Rs.1600 per annum, limited to the actual expenditure incurred by the student on transportation charges etc. will be paid to the scholars studying professional and technical courses, provided that the head of the institution certifies that the study tour is essential for the scholar for completion of his/her course of study.

(v) Thesis Typing/Printing Charges

Thesis typing/printing charges up to a maximum of Rs.1600 will be paid to research scholars on the recommendation of the Head of the Institution.

(vi) Book Allowance for Students pursuing Correspondence / Distance Education Courses

The students pursuing such courses are also eligible for an annual allowance of Rs.1200/-for essential/prescribed books, besides reimbursement of course fees.

(vii) Book Banks

- I. Book Banks are to be set up in all the Medical, Engineering, Agriculture, Law and Veterinary Degree Colleges and Institutes imparting Chartered Accountancy, MBA and alike Management courses and Polytechnics where Scheduled Caste students are in receipt of Post Matric Scholarship. The set of text books will be purchased for 2 such SC students at various stages except in respect of Post-graduate courses and Chartered Accountancy where it will be one set for each student. However, the ratio of sets and students will have to be adjusted to the total number of sets that could be procured within the total resources allocated to the State concerned.
- II. The details of courses covered for setting up of Book Banks, ceiling of admissible expenditure per set of books and sharing criteria are given below:

For storage of books and contingencies etc., the cost of steel almirah for storing books of each Book Bank including contingencies like transportation etc. the following expenses are admissible:

(i) Rs. 2000 or actual cost whichever is less.

(ii) 5% of the grant may be earmarked for expenses on binding, stiching etc.

Note: The said sets of books also include Braille Books, Talking Books, and Cassettes for the visually Handicapped students.

- III. The Book Banks are to be set up in all the recognized colleges/institutions where these courses are being offered as recognized courses.
- IV. Purchase of books for these Book Banks will be restricted to the prescribed text books for the entire courses.
- V. The State Governments may constitute Expert Groups consisting of members from selected colleges/educational institutions of different regions to decide the adequate number of text books in a set (not reference books) required for each course.
- VI. The life period of one set of books has been fixed at 3 years. Thereafter the books may be disposed of by the institutions in the same manner as the books in the library subject to the guidelines, if any, of the State Government/UT Administration in this regard.
- VII. These books are to be supplied to SC students in installments, depending on the course, semester structure etc.
- VIII. The following rules shall govern the distribution of books to the students:
 - (i) Each SC student will be provided with an identity card for this purpose.
 - (ii) Each SC student will be required to submit requisition for borrowing books from the Book Bank in a form to be provided for this purpose.
 - (iii) The books would be returned to the Book Bank at the end of each term. The Principal of the college/institution will make every effort to ensure that those students who complete their course or those who drop out in the middle return the books belonging to the Book Bank.
 - (iv) It is the responsibility of the student concerned to maintain the books supplied to them from the Book Bank, in good condition.
 - (v) Any case of loss or damage to the books would attract penalty. In case of serious damage or loss of books, the student concerned will have to bear the cost of the book.

VII. Selection of Candidates

- 1. All the eligible Scheduled Caste candidates will be given scholarships subject to the application of Means Test prescribed in this Scheme.
- 2. a) Candidates belonging to one State but studying in other State will be awarded scholarships by the State to which they belong or

b) Students domiciled in a State/UT but holding SC Certificate in other State/UT can avail scholarship in State/UT of domicile subject to verification of the SC certificate from State where it was issued. The conditions of domicile will be as determined by the State/UT as the case may be. The domicile State/UT shall keep the parent State informed with all particulars.

VIII. Duration and Renewal of Awards

- 1. The award once made will be payable from the stage at which it is given to the completion of course subject to good conduct and attendance of 75% in every academic year.
- 2. If a scholar is unable to appear in the annual examination owing to illness, the award may be renewed subject to production of medical certificate from prescribed authority and acceptance of the same by institution /college.
- 3. If according to the Regulations of a University/Institution, a student is promoted to the next higher class even though he/she may not have actually passed in lower class and is required to take examination of the junior class again after sometime, he/she will be entitled to scholarship for the class to which he/she is promoted if the student is otherwise eligible for scholarship.

IX. Payment

1. Maintenance allowance is payable from 1st April or from the month of admission, whichever is later, to the month in which the examinations are completed, at the end of the academic year (including maintenance allowance during holidays), provided that

if the scholar secures admission after the 20th day of a month, the amount will be paid from the month following the month of admission for a period of ten months/ duration of the course.

- In case of renewal of scholarships awarded in the previous years, maintenance allowance will be paid from the month following the month up to which scholarship was paid in the previous year, if the course of study is continuous.
- 3. The Government of the State/Union Territory Administration will pay the non-refundable fees and maintenance fees in to the account of the students. Incidental to above changes, Ministry's D.O No. 14012/2/2010-SCD-VI dated October 06,2010 addressed to Principal Secretaries/ Secretaries (SW) of all States/UTs regarding instructions to all private institutions not to charge any tuition fee from eligible SC students at the time of admission stands withdrawn. The State government / UT administration will frame modalities regarding periodical and timely release of Scholarship (including fees) to student's accounts; so that students can pay the fees to the institution on time and not be subjected to any penalties for late payment/ non-payment of fees.
- 4. Scholarship will not be paid for the period of internship/ housemanship in the M.B.B.S. course or for a practical training in other course if the student is in receipt of some remuneration during the internship period or some allowance/stipend during the practical training in other course.

X. Mode of Disbursal of Scholarship

1. Payment of scholarship/ maintenance and any other admissible allowances:

(i) Payment of scholarship/ maintenance and any other admissible allowance should be made to beneficiaries through their accounts in post offices/banks. The Ministry of Social Justice vide notification number 428 dated Feb,16,2017 has notified Aadhaar as identity document under Section 7 of Aadhaar Act 2016 for all Scholarship Schemes w.e.f. 16th February 2017. The States henceforth will make provisions for capturing details of Aadhaar, Aadhaar EID and other alternative documents as provided for in the said notification on their respective Scholarship portals or otherwise.

(ii) Non-refundable fee to students should be released in the following order of priority:

- i. Students studying in Government Educational Bodies including Central and State Universities.
- ii. Students studying in Government aided Schools/ Colleges/ Institutions.
- iii. Students studying in Private institutions affiliated to Central/State Universities.
- iv. Students studying in other institutions.

(iii) All States/UTs availing of benefits under post-matric scholarship scheme will migrate to online processing of disbursal of scholarships within one year of the revised scheme coming into effect. The scholarship portal should mandatorily have the following features:

- a. Every student should be assigned an Aadhaar ID, Aadhaar EID and other alternative form of ID as per this Ministry's notification no. 428 dated 16.02.2017 which will enable elimination of duplication and false claims.
- b. The District Collector will nominate Group 'Á' officers to inspect all private institutes offering courses at the level of graduation or above during the year preferably by the time of closure of admission.
- c. Online verification of eligibility credentials such as caste certificates, income certificates, mark-sheets etc. should be mandatorily provided.
- d. DBT to the students' account in respect of maintenance and non-refundable fees.
- e. Provision for application of renewal scholarships online.

2. Disbursal of arrears: Central Assistance towards arrear shall be disbursed in the following manner:

a. Where the State Government has released the scholarship to Students after making due provision in the budget and claimed reimbursement of the same, the arrears due and admissible will be considered for release as per regulations of PMS (SC) Scheme.

- b. In case the State Government has not released scholarship to Students and have claimed the arrears towards pending past claims, in such cases the State govt. will follow procedure as given below:
 - i. Where the Institutes have not charged the non-refundable fees from students; the state shall verify such claims with the concerned students and also furnish a complete list of such students, institute wise, while forwarding arrears claims to the ministry (in the context of pre-revised cases).
 - ii. Where Institute have charged non-refundable fees from students, the State shall furnish a complete list of such students, along with details of their bank accounts and Aadhaar number institution wise while forwarding arrear claims to the ministry. The arrears should be released invariably through DBT in to the accounts of students.

XI. Other Conditions for the Award

- i. The scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress and conduct of the scholar. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution at any time that a scholar has by reasons of his/her own act of default failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance without the permission of the authorities concerned etc., the authority sanctioning the scholarship may either cancel the scholarships or stop or withhold further payment for such period as it may think fit.
- ii. If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statements, his/ her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered, at the discretion of the concerned State Government. The student concerned will be blacklisted and debarred for scholarship in any scheme forever.
- iii. A scholarship awarded may be cancelled if the scholar changes the subject of the course of study for which the scholarship was originally awarded or changes the Institution of study, without prior approval of the State Government. The Head of the Institution shall report such cases to them and stop payment of the

scholarship money. The amount already paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the State Government.

- iv. A scholar is liable to refund the scholarship amount at the discretion of the State Government, if during the course of the year, the studies for which the scholarship has been awarded, is discontinued by him/her.
- v. The provisions of this scheme can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Government of India.

XII. Announcement of the Scheme

All the State Governments/UT Administrations will announce in May-June, the details of the scheme and invite applications by issuing an advertisement in the leading newspapers of the State and through their respective websites/ Scholarship portals and other mode of media. All requests for application forms and other particulars should be addressed to the Government of State/Union Territory Administration to which the scholars actually belong. The applicant should submit the completed application to the prescribed authority before the last date prescribed for receipt of applications.

XIII. Procedure for applying

- (i) An application for scholarship can be made online on scholarship portal where available and in hard copy otherwise. Where applying online, the documents may be scanned and uploaded. Hard copy of application uploaded will be submitted as per the requirement of portal where application has been made. Every application whether done online or in hard copy will at the minimum compulsorily include:
 - a. One copy of the application for scholarship in the prescribed form.
 - b. One copy of the passport size photograph with signatures of the student thereon (for fresh scholarship).
 - c. One self-attested copy of certificates, diploma, degree etc. in respect of all examinations passed.

- d. A certificate of Caste duly signed by an authorized Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- e. Income declaration of self-employed parents/guardian should be in the form of a certificate issued by Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. Employed parents/guardians are required to obtain income certificate from their employer. Employed parents/ guardians should obtain consolidated certificate from Revenue officer for any other additional source of income.
- f. Application for scholarship should be submitted by student by 30th November of the academic year in which he is studying, provided that for valid reasons State authorities may extend the last date.

(Note: Where hard copy is submitted all copies should be self-attested)

(ii) Application complete in all respects shall be submitted to the Head of the Institution, being attended or last attended by the candidates and shall be addressed to an officer specified for this purpose by the Government of State/Union Territory to which the student belongs, in accordance with the instructions issued by them from time to time.

XIV. Procedure for forwarding demand for release of Central Assistance (CA) for PMS-SC by State Government/Union Administration

- a. The aggregated demand of the State/UT to Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment should be submitted in the prescribed format.
- b. Demand for CA submitted beyond 31st December will not be entertained.
- c. The demand for the current F/Y should be in respect of student's scholarship for the corresponding academic year. Arrears due to non-release of CA of previous years should be shown separately.

XV. Funding Pattern of the Scheme

The Scheme is implemented by the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations, which receive 100% central assistance from Government of India for the total expenditure

under the scheme, over and above their respective Committed Liability. "The level of Committed Liability of respective State Government / Union Territory administration in a New Finance Commission (FC) cycle annually will be equivalent to the total of the demand on the State as well as the Central Government in the terminal year of the previous Plan period/ Finance Commission (FC) cycle, provided that when a State has made no demand on the Centre in the terminal year of the Plan period/ Finance Commission cycle or the demand made by a State is lower than in any of the previous years of the plan period / Finance commission cycle, in that case the highest demand made in any of the previous financial years of the Plan/ Finance Commission cycle will be considered as demand of the State on Centre for the purpose of computation of Committed Liability for the next Finance Commission cycle is required to be borne by them for which they are required to make required provision in their own budget." The committed Liability so computed will be coterminus with the FC cycle. The North Eastern States have, however, been exempted from making their own budgetary provisions towards Committee Liability from Ninth Plan Period (1997-2002) onwards and the entire expenditure under the Scheme in respect of them will be borne by Government of India.

All the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations implementing the scheme will:

- Furnish data of beneficiaries and expenditure under the scheme, to Government of India, regularly in the Quarterly Reports prescribed for this purpose. Financial assistance given under the scheme shall not be utilized for any other purpose.
- ii) DBT Monthly report as per proforma under DBT Bharat Portal.
- Designate Grievance Redressal Officers (GROs) at the State and District levels to redress students' scholarship-related grievances.

XVI. Effective implementation/ alteration of modalities

a. For the purposes of effective implementation of the Scheme, implementing States may formulate guidelines for assessing eligibility of beneficiaries & institutions and modalities for Direct benefit transfer, which shall be in accordance with the objectives of the Scheme provided that the States shall not be at liberty to impose any guideline which enhances or has the effect of enhancing the liability of the Centre under the Scheme.

b. The Centre may call for reports from time to time and issue guidelines for effective implementation. The guidelines and eligibility norms of the scheme may also be changed by Central government as deemed necessary.

XVI. Inspection and Monitoring of the scheme:

The States/ Union Territories implementing the scheme shall monitor physical and financial performance of the scheme at the States/ Union Territories level. For this purpose, an IT enabled monitoring mechanism shall be in place. The States/ Union Territories will be required to furnish quarterly financial and physical progress reports to the Ministry. The States/ Union Territories shall maintain year wise details of the students receiving scholarship, indicating school/ college/ institute, location of school/ college/ institute, government or private, class, gender and new or renewal. The States/ Union Territories shall place relevant physical and financial details in their official website. All the State/ UT governments will ensure that all private institutions are annually inspected by Group 'A' officer,

XVI. Evaluation

The performance of the scheme will be evaluated by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (GOI) at least once every three years, to begin with.

XVII. Administrative Charges

The Centre will have a budgetary provision of administrative cost, which will be equivalent to 1% of funds released by the Centre to States in the terminal year of the previous plan period. The States/UTs can seek administrative charges towards implementing, monitoring etc. the scheme, up to 1% of the funds released and stipulated above to that particular

State. Out of above Centre can also avail 10% budget for its own administrative and monitoring expenses.

XVIII. Transitory provision for existing beneficiaries

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Beneficiaries of scholarships under the pre-revised Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SCs will continue to be governed by terms and conditions as prevailed before amendment of the scheme till completion of the course for which he/she is availing Scholarship. (However, redefined committed liability to State Govts/ UT administrations will be applicable from the year 2017-18.)
